EXHIBITOR REQUIREMENTS AND PROCEDURES

Thank you for your interest in the Florida Flywheelers.

We are sorry, but we are unable to accept reservations over the phone or the internet. We are all volunteers, and cannot be available at all times.

The procedure to obtain sites is to show up in person starting on Thursday, the week before the show starts, we are open 8:00 A.M. to 6:00 P. M. each day until the show starts then during the show, 7:00 A.M. to 9:00 A.M. and 4:00 P.M. to 6:00 P.M. The available sites are on a first come first served basis.

An exhibit consists of antique engines, tractors, cars, or other related equipment. To qualify as an exhibitor, the Club rules specify that 50% of each site must be covered by the exhibit. The sites are 25 ft. frontage by 20 ft. deep. The exhibit must NOT be for sale. We request you show all 4 days. The public is paying to come in to see exhibits all 4 days. We do not charge a fee for exhibitors and supply limited electricity on most sites. The electric is not enough to run an R.V. air conditioner coffee pot or heater. Depending upon your arrival date, we cannot guarantee electric sites will be available.

NOTE:

Starting with the January 2017 show, there will be a \$10.00 per exhibitor per day fee for staying overnight on Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday, the week before the show starts. You may come in to set up, If you do not stay on the grounds you do not pay the fee.

Also please note, during the show days, no vehicle traffic is permitted on the show grounds between 9: 00 a. m. and 4:00 p.m. Safety of our patrons is very important to us. Vehicles cannot move until after 4:00 p.m.
